





Ohio County-Level Diabetes Prevalence 2010

In Ohio, 50% of the counties with the highest prevalence of diabetes in the state do not have within their borders, or within a 5-mile radius, an American Diabetes Association (ADA)-approved program for diabetes self-management education. In addition, 34.8% of those counties at the next highest level of diabetes prevalence do not contain, or are within 5 miles of, an ADA-approved program as well.
