


Population coverage of CDC-recognized Diabetes Prevention Program (DPP) locations within 15 and 30 minute drive times, Ohio 2014



Utilizing the population-weighted centroid of census block groups and the location of the 13 CDC-recognized DPP locations in Ohio, this geospatial analysis shows that only 27.3 percent of Ohioans live within a 15 minute drive of an Ohio DPP location. An additional 29.9 percent live within a 30 minute drive. The current infrastructure of CDC-recognized DPP providers only covers 57.2 percent of Ohioans, leaving nearly 5 million people without ready access to these services.
