### Meeting Notes

**Meeting opened with introductions.**

#### **Violence and Injury Prevention Program (VIPP) Update: Jolene Defiore-Hyrmer and Sara Morman**

- **Organizational Update-** The Ohio Department of Health (ODH) is currently in an organizational process. The work completed by VIPP will continue and will be located in the Bureau of Health Promotion. We continue to work on filling vacancies within the program.
- **Grant Opportunities-** VIPP recently completed the continuation application for current Core Grant Funding for injury. VIPP also submitted a grant for Prescription Drug Overdose (PDO) to improve the automated prescription system (OARRS) in terms of access, usage, and monitoring. This opportunity will also focus on the prescribing guidelines and target the high risk counties within the state for PDO.
- **Funding-** The Federal budget continued the PHHSBG and identified additional funding to focus on prescription drug overdose at a state and local level.
- **Injury Priorities-** VIPP has submitted request for proposals (RFP) to the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) for partners to assist with our injury priorities. RFP's include implementation of the Stopping Elderly Accidents, Deaths, and Injuries (STEADI) Tool Kit into health care practices and a contract was awarded to RAMA Consulting Group in partnership with Ohio Health. This pilot will give ODH and OIPP an opportunity to identify best practices, lessons learned, and integration of falls assessment into the electronic record. The Infant Safe Sleep Community Engagement was awarded to SID Network of Ohio.
- **Data Products-** Updated fact sheets on mortality and information pertaining to PDO are available on the ODH website at <http://www.healthy.ohio.gov/vipp/drug/dpoison.aspx>.
- **Policy-** The 3<sup>rd</sup> edition of the policy guide is currently being compiled by the Center for Injury Research and Policy At the Research Institute at Nationwide Children's Hospital. The Legislative Tracker has been updated. The PowerPrism Workshop will take place June 26<sup>th</sup>.
- **Partnerships-** The Trauma Committee works with several partners with a trauma system framework. In this plan many of the goals of the OIPP have been adopted. The injury portion of the assessment has greatly increased in capacity since the inception of the plan. This committee is an excellent opportunity for engagement with Injury Prevention and the Trauma Systems.

#### **Review of OIPP Bylaws**

- The Leadership Team reviewed the bylaws and suggested amendments were made the vote from the membership will take place at the OIPP annual meeting in November of 2015.

#### **Review of Strategic Plan**

- Updating the OIPP Strategic Plan was discussed among members.
- The plan was distributed and the leadership will review and make amendments at the August meeting.

#### **August Agenda for OIPP Main Meeting**

- The August meeting will feature a topic for Prescription Drug Overdose/Abuse.
