



Tobacco Free Schools Signage Requests

School districts wishing to receive “100% Tobacco Free School” signage will need to submit their policy to the Ohio Department of Health for review. To qualify for free signs, the policy will need to include the following components:

For student, staff, and visitors, the policy must do all of the following:

- A. Prohibit all tobacco (tobacco free only)
 - a. In all school facilities and buildings
 - b. On school grounds, athletic grounds and parking lots
 - c. At all school sponsored events off campus
 - d. At all times (24/7)
- B. Contain an enforcement provision
- C. Prohibit possession of tobacco products and tobacco paraphernalia by students
