

## 2014 Adams County Creating Healthy Communities Interventions

### Healthy Eating

#### *School*

- The Ohio Valley School District will increase the availability of fresh fruits and vegetables by expanding the school garden and piloting a “Farm to Fork” program with Peebles Elementary School.
- Manchester Local School District will increase the availability of healthy food and beverage choices for after-school and sporting events.

### Active Living

#### *Community*

- The Village of Peebles will expand the Peebles Youth Sports Complex to include a walking path or skateboard park.
- The Village of Manchester will make infrastructure changes to the Safe Routes to School walking path and Nathaniel Massie Community Park.
- The Village of West Union will increase physical activity opportunities for its residents by adding a walking path or playground within the village.
- The Adams-Brown Creating Healthy Communities Program will continue to support the Adams-Brown Diabetes Education Coalition with the Coalition’s healthy eating and active living strategies.

#### *Worksite*

- Adams-Brown Community Action Program and Adams County Commissioners will develop and adopt a shared use agreement for the use of the West Union Nutrition site for county employee fitness activities.

### Tobacco Free Living

#### *Worksite*

- First State Bank-Manchester will adopt a 100% comprehensive tobacco- free worksite/campus policy.

#### *School*

- Ohio Valley School District will adopt a 100% comprehensive tobacco-free campus policy.
