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
Overall Participation

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How long have you been involved with the OIPP?





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
How are you currently involved with OIPP? (Select all that apply)

- Communication from an Action Group 7.0%



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


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How would you rate your overall satisfaction as a member of the OIPP?





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

- Participating in conference call is difficult due to technological issues



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
How could OIPP meetings be improved


What educational or professional development opportunities would be a priority for 2015?
