- Served as primary sponsor and co-sponsor of healthcare legislation.



# Lessons I've Learned About Healthcare

- Important role of local public health.
- Healthcare delivery system is fragmented and lacks coordination.
- Financial incentives for volume (more care) over value (better care/lower cost).
- Not everyone has good access to care, especially primary care.
- Emphasis on treating illness instead of preventing illness.
- ROI on healthcare spending not in line with outcomes.



# Challenges and Transformation

Public health and clinical care fields are being challenged and transformed by Federal and State efforts to address healthcare issues.

# Transforming Healthcare in Ohio

## State Innovation Model (SIM)

- Ohio 1 of 16 states to receive 2013 CMS State Innovation Model design grant.
  - Grants support state-led, multi-stakeholder healthcare payment and service delivery innovations.
- Ohio also 1 of 7 states selected to implement comprehensive primary care initiative to foster collaboration among public and private payers to strengthen primary care.

# Transforming Healthcare in Ohio


## Emphasis on Population Health Management

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


